

Te Tāruke-ā-Tāwhiri: Auckland's Climate Plan

<u>Te Tāruke-ā-Tāwhiri: Auckland's Climate Plan</u> states that Auckland, and Auckland Council, will plan for the climate change impacts faced under a high emissions pathway, which may result in an average warming of 3.5 degrees or more by 2110. However, further information on specific technical assumptions is not provided in the Plan.

Auckland Council has developed a guideline document titled 'Climate Change Scenarios' which addresses this by providing projections to be used across the Auckland Council group for temperature, high intensity rainfall and sea-level rise.

This guideline document, GD15, is attached.
